











## SMOKER AWARENESS OF E-CIGARETTES VARIES WIDELY BY COUNTRY






# **SMOKERS REMAIN CONFUSED ABOUT E-CIGARETTES WITH ONLY 12% BEING VERY FAMILIAR**






#### MOST E-CIGARETTE USERS USE THEM EXCLUSIVELY






## MOST HAVE USED E-CIGARETTES LESS THAN A YEAR






# A MAJORITY STARTED USING E-CIGARETTES AS AN ALTERNATIVE TO REGULAR CIGARETTES






## E-CIGARETTES ARE PRIMARILY BOUGHT AT SPECIALTY STORES






## **BARRIERS TO USAGE OF E-CIGARETTES**





## **E-CIGARETTES ARE SEEN AS A POSITIVE ALTERNATIVE**






#### MOST ADULT SMOKERS WOULD CONSIDER SWITCHING


## MOST AGREE GOVERNMENTS WOULD BE WRONG TO IMPEDE AVAILABILITY




#### MOST AGREE GOVERNMENTS SHOULD ENCOURAGE A SWITCH
